**Edi Šiljak** is a violinist whose performances blend old-world elegance with artistic imagination. Inspired by the great masters of the 20th century, he reinvents the violin's voice, uncovering new colors and stories, whether reimagining a Chopin nocturne or exploring beloved gems of the repertoire.

With a passion for adaptation and discovery, he collaborates with instrumentalists and composers to craft programs that surprise and captivate, offering fresh perspectives on violin's vast expressive potential. His artistry transcends traditional boundaries, transforming music originally written for other instruments into violin-centric narratives that speak directly to the heart.

Born in Rijeka, Croatia, he earned the highest awards as a City of Rijeka scholarship recipient, including First Prize as a soloist at the International Lions Grand Prix Competition in 2009, becoming the first violinist solo performer in the history of this competition in Croatia to win the highest award. He graduated from the Zagreb Academy of Music with prof. Orest Shourgot and has since performed throughout Croatia and numerous European countries.

He serves as concertmaster of the Istrian Chamber Orchestra.

He is a featured artist on the YouTube channel of iClassical Academy, one of the world's leading online platforms for music masterclasses.

As an educator, he has garnered international interest for his innovative approach to teaching, fostering confidence and inspiring students while guiding them to grasp the deeper essence of technique and music through a collaborative partnership in learning. His commitment to teaching has connected him with students worldwide through online platforms, enriching their musical journeys with his expertise. He leads a violin masterclass at the International Summer Music School in Pučišća on the island of Brač.

He performs on master violins crafted by his father, violin maker Robert Šiljak Toffetti. This unique connection imbues his performances with personal depth, celebrating a legacy of artistry and craftsmanship.
